# What to expect at Irish Rising

**Morning Sessions**  
These sessions will focus primarily on individual skill development. Coaches will run drills from their programs in an effort to hone skills.  
**Lunch**  
Will be provided everyday by Anheuser Busch Center.  
**Afternoon Sessions**  
These sessions will build throughout the week, capitalizing on the morning skill development. During team play, campers will focus on unsettled situations. Afternoons will culminate in team scrimmages, coached by our staff.

## Divisions for Camp

**9-11 Grade Division:**  
This will separate the players with multiple years experience into one group. These players will focus on skills that are directly related to the High School game. Campers will be divided by position and skilled.  
**5-8 Grade Division:**  
This division is for campers with little to no experience. Fundamentals will be stressed with a focus on learning on the basic skills necessary to improve in lacrosse.

**\*\*Note:** players will be divided by grade and SKILL level. Players will be moved up and down during camp to ensure they are with campers of similar skill sets.
